In brief the book describes my activities along with my friends with whom as trainspotters in the late 1950s I travelled extensively during those years to 4th August 1968, when steam finished on BR., We used many forms of transport such as Mini buses, Coaches, Trains, Bicycles, Motorbikes, Cars, even Hitchhiking and Ferries! Many amusing incidents occurred through the period which are included in the book, such as a contretemps with a herd of Bullocks, our coach catching fire on the M1, the Castleford 'Snow' incident, some strange overnight encounters, hitchhiking a lift on a 9F and of course run-ins with various Shed Foremen!
